Job Description

Job Title: Field Representative

Reports To: Field Supervisor

FLSA Status: Non-Exempt

Summary: Performs various demolition tasks, maintains work area, and practices good safety habits by performing the following duties. Is within the 90 day introductory period.

Duties and Responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

1. Works on a team to perform tasks as directed by team leader or field supervisor.*
2. Operates power tools to include: air compressor, jackhammer, concrete saw, trencher, skill saw, hydraulic or electric winch and powder actuated fasteners.*
3. Maintains a clean and safe work environment at all times by sweeping, cleaning and removing trash.*
4. Maintains and upkeeps property, tools, equipment and materials at all times.*
5. Reports maintenance issues to supervisor.*
6. Complies with company policies and procedures giving special attention to safety regulations.*
7. Works effectively with others and takes direction as necessary.*
8. Wears appropriate clothing and safety equipment at all times.*
9. Records all hours performed on the job site and turns them into their supervisor daily*
10. Attends all staff meetings.*

Qualifications:

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Language, Math, and Reasoning Ability:

Ability to read and comprehend simple instructions, short correspondence, and memos. Ability to write simple correspondence. Ability to effectively present information in one-on-one and small group situations to customers, clients, and other employees of the organization.

Ability to add, subtract, multiply, and divide in all units of measure, using whole numbers, common fractions, and decimals. Ability to compute rate, ratio, and percent and to draw and interpret bar graphs.

Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out detailed but uninvolved written or oral instructions.

Ability to deal with problems involving a few concrete variables in standardized situations.

Knowledge, Skills, and Other Abilities: Time management skills, oral and written communication skills, professionalism

Physical Demands:

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand, walk, use hands, reach with hands and arms, climb or balance, stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl, talk or hear, and taste or smell. The employee is occasionally required to sit. The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to 75 or more pounds.

Work Environment:

The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly exposed to work near moving mechanical parts. The employee is frequently exposed to work in high, precarious places, fumes or airborne particles, and risk of electrical shock. The employee is occasionally exposed to toxic or caustic chemicals, outdoor weather conditions, and vibration.

The noise level in the work environment is usually loud.
